

An application for a permit for keeping a pet in the flat must be submitted before bringing the pet in!

The pet permit is granted against a pet collateral of 134 €per pet or cage (excluding fish tanks).
When applying for a pet permit for several pets, the collateral for subsequent pets is 67 €per pet.
If you live in a cell flat, you also need consent from your flat mates (also when they change).

Pets cannot be kept in the following houses: Arvosoppi house A, Citysoppi staircase A, Koskisoppi houses C and H.

A copy of the decision is delivered to the applicant once the pet collateral has been paid.

If, upon moving out, the flat is in good condition and the pet has not caused other nuisance, the pet collateral will be refunded within one month from the termination of tenancy agreement or from the date on which the pet left the flat.

If the pet causes nuisance to the neighbours or to the building, the house manager has the right to terminate the tenancy agreement.
